Under the following conditions:

Rock Llewelin Setters ("RLS", "breeder") has put a lot of time and effort into carefully raising this puppy. The sire and dam had been bred with the purpose of producing quality and healthy puppies suitable for hunting and companionship.

RLS will provide the purchaser with Field Dog Stud Book application papers, this day or within a reasonable amount of time, at no extra cost. The purchaser will also receive with the dog and Bill of Sale, its Health Record, Nutrition Information, Spay and Neuter Information, Recommendations, Microchip Registration Application, Emergency Contact Form, Familiar Commands and Schedule, and Unofficial Pedigree (official may be obtained from the FDSB).

The purchaser agrees to keep the breeder listed as the emergency or alternate contact in the dog's microchip database.

The buyer **must** be the person taking care of the dog; RLS will **not** sell puppies to third parties or as surprises. Should a person wish to buy a pup as a gift, RLS requires the Bill of Sale to be signed by the person receiving the pup.

By the time the buyer has received the puppy, it will have started a series of vaccinations and dewormings that will need to be completed by buyer's veterinarian.

Breeder's liability will be limited to, and in no event shall exceed the purchase price of the dog involved. The purchaser accepts any health conditions that he/she has been notified of by breeder. The breeder advises that the buyer have the puppy examined by his or her own veterinarian within three days of the delivery and that the purchaser sends a copy of the examination/record to breeder within a period of one week of examination. If a novel concern is found during the recommended post-purchase vet exam that resulted because of the breeder's care, the purchaser should contact RLS within 48 hours and reasonable solutions will be discussed. Should the purchaser neglect the examination within the specified time period, RLS will accept no liability for any acute health concerns, as it will be the purchaser's responsibility to maintain the health of the pup. The puppy will be covered by an extended hereditary health guarantee until his/her third birthday for conditions screened for in OFA hip, elbow, thyroid, and eye tests; however, factors that will be considered in the resolution for any joint issues will include any veterinary record/note that the dog is overweight (or was during growth), or if the dog was spayed or neutered before one year of age, upon which a mutually reasonable resolution will be reached.

The dog **may not** be sold or given away without an **express written and signed agreement** from the breeder. If there is a time when the dog must change homes, RLS will have prior purchase rights

at that time for a period of two weeks from notification. The selling or giving away of the dog to a third party is only allowable after consultation with RLS so that it may be sure that the dog will be living in an acceptable home throughout its life. At no point in this dog's life may it be surrendered to a rescue or shelter; purchaser has the responsibility to contact breeder if an emergency arises.

If the dog is to be bred, the purchaser must wait until dog reaches the age of two years old, hunt or compete with the dog, register with the FDSB, complete DNA testing, and at minimum complete OFA hip, elbow, and eye screening. The purchaser must also remain in contact with RLS if they are planning on breeding.

The purchaser will be expected to provide veterinary care, when appropriate. Appropriate times may include emergencies, vaccinations, health checks, and other health care issues. The purchaser will be expected to provide a clean, healthy environment for the dog to live in, to exercise, socialize and train the dog, and to not keep him contained in an outdoor kennel or tie out as his primary living conditions.

RLS ensures that all pups exhibit natural hunting abilities by the time of the sale; however, it is the purchaser's responsibility to continue the dog's training, provide a variety of positive experiences in hunting environments, and maintain a supportive, gentle upbringing conducive to learning and confidence. RLS strongly urges the buyer to not to use harsh training methods that heavily rely on corrections, fear/intimidation, or pain/discomfort.
